R.M. of Grassy Creek No. 78 Snow Plow Policy Resolution 217/04

Passed December 16, 2004

- Approved as amended December 18, 2019
- 1. All snow removal operations to be approved by the Councillor in his/her division before work commences.
 - a. All bills to be presented monthly to be approved by council.
 - b. All equipment rates to be approved by Council.
 - c. All bills to indicate tractor horsepower, size and type of snow removal equipment.
- 2. All tractors must be equipped with an amber flashing beacon, visible from any horizontal angle for 125 meters on a clear night.
- 3. Operators must be eligible to operate a vehicle and be recognized in the minutes of the municipality.
- 4. The Councillors must go through the Reeve or Deputy Reeve to send out the R.M.'s graders.
- 5. Municipal Roads take precedence over all other snow removal. Primary Grid #722 having first priority, with other main roads and areas as common sense would dictate.
- 6. The removal of snow in ratepayer's yards, to access graineries, cattle or any other special requests to plough roads not routinely opened, shall be classified as Custom Work, and charged out accordingly.
 - a. A special call shall be charged out based on the time the grader leaves the shop, until it returns.
 - b. The operators are authorized to use their discretion in determining if the project can be completed safely, and may refuse to proceed if determined that it is unwise to do so.
 - c. When ploughing on private property, the ratepayer is to be present at the time of ploughing, and a hold harmless agreement must be signed before proceeding.
